## **Words on Wheels Application**

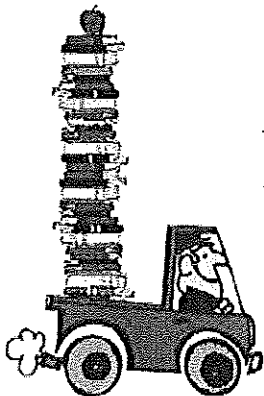
What is Words on Wheels? Homebound Service is the free delivery of library materials to residents who live in Enfield and who are unable to travel to the library. A doctor or a certified health care provider must fill out the bottom of the form.

Is there a charge for this service? No, this is a free service. However, you must have an Enfield Public Library card.

How does this service work? Homebound deliveries are made once a month by a member of the Enfield Public Library or Friends of the Enfield Library. Materials will be selected for you by the Library staff using your Reading Interest form.

How long do I get the materials for? The loan period is 1(one) month.
